- To support our congregation with the gifts God has given you, using those gifts to help proclaim the gospel of Christ to our members, community and world.
- To conduct yourself at all times as it becomes a minister of Christ (1 Timothy 3:2-7; Titus 1:7-9), so that by your Christian life you may be an example to all people (Matthew 5:16); and to devote your time, strength and ability to the general advancement of the kingdom of Christ and to the gathering in of his harvest;

- To assist the pastor(s) when called upon with proclaiming the Gospel of our Lord in its truth and purity and administering the Sacraments;
- As your call provides the opportunity, to instruct and train the students in your charge diligently and faithfully in harmony and in accord with the Word of God as revealed in the canonical books of the Old and the New Testament and professed in the confessional writings of the Lutheran Church as contained in the Book of Concord of 1580;
- To promote spiritual growth by assisting us in a vibrant ministry to and by all generations of our church family, noting especially the primary role of parents in faith nurture (Deut. 6:4-9); and
- To perform other duties as mutually agreed upon, including those more specifically detailed in a job description for this position.

- To support your work among us with our prayers and personal assistance;
- To cooperate and participate with you in the gospel ministry (Matthew 28:18-21) using our spiritual gifts to edify and build up the body of the Christ (1 Corinthians 12:27-28); and
