


# Devotional thought

2020 total congregational offerings \$306 million (lower than recent years)








- 2020 Congregation Mission Offerings (CMO) totaled \$21.74 million, which is the highest total on record and 2.3 percent (\$498,000) more than CMO 2019 for the same period and 3.0 percent higher (\$633,000) than projected 2020 receipts.






■ Subscriptions ■ Actual












- 2.1% of personal income to offerings

By God's grace, we have received \$100 million in gifts and expectancies since 2005 and will distribute \$1 million in July from the WELS Missions and Ministerial Education Endowment Funds!







#### **Congregation Mission Offerings**

- 2021 subscriptions point to a decrease of 0.9 percent from 2020 actual offerings.
- **Through June**, offerings total \$10.3 million, which is 8.9 percent more than 2020 CMO for the same period and 7.2 percent higher than 2021 projected receipts.

#### **Congregation Mission Offerings**

- When setting CMO, aim for ten percent of offerings. If at or above this goal, encourage your congregation to maintain its generous support or consider increasing it as you're able with God's blessing.
- "For if the willingness is there, the gift is acceptable according to what one has, not according to what one does not have" (2 Corinthians 8:12).
- "Excel in this grace of giving. . . . For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Corinthians 8:7,9).





In fiscal year 2020-21 (through May), WELS Christian giving counselors (13.23 full-time equivalents) conducted 598 free, confidential in-person visits and 622 substantive phone/virtual meetings with God's people that helped facilitate \$9.4 million in gifts received and \$17.4 million in new and revised deferred expectancies for congregations, synod, and other WELS organizations.

Consider directing required minimum distributions to ministry to save on taxes, then using the cash you would have given to charity for other needs.



#### Supporting MLC Students through an Endowment

WELS members David and Lynette Buss have been longtime supporters of Jesus' work through WELS ministries, including their local congregation and area Lutheran high school.

Recently, the Busses decided to do more to support gospel ministry out of gratifude to God for his blessings. "We read an article about Martin Luther College (MLC) in a flyer from WELS," David recalls, "and we knew we needed to distribute our blessings to people in the ministry field."

David contacted Rev. Thomas Mielke, his local WELS Christian giving courselor, to assist in setting up an endowment through WELS Foundation. An endowment is a permanent fund designed to make steady annual distributions that increase as the fund grows and gifts are added. The Busses' endowment would provide ongoing tuttion assistance for MLC students.

"David and lynette have always been supportive of students studying for the ministry," says Rev. Mielke. "They think it's wonderful that students dedicate their lives to teaching and preaching to share the gospel. They consider it an honor to help offset rising tuition costs for these students."

David agrees: "This is one way of helping spread the gospel as we reduce tuition costs so pastors, teachers, and staff ministers can continue their work. This will help a lot of different ministry fields—both local ministry and outreach into mission fields."

The Busses understand an endowment fund is an ideal way to support MLC students for years to come. "This fund will grow as long as we are on this earth, and it will continue to grow and help hundreds of students in future years," says David.

Through WELS Foundation, an individual, family, congation, or any WELS-affiliated ministry can set up a designated endowment that creates a lasting legacy of Christian faith while carrying out the Lord's work. An endowment can be established with cash or appreciated assets, or through a will, trust, beneficiary designation on a retirement account, or insurance proceeds.

The Busses appreciate the one-on-one assistance they received from Rev. Mielke and urge others to take advantage of the benefits of working with a WELS Christian giving counselor.




