 $\textbf{Subject:} \ \textit{Continuing education requirement for positions that exercise authority over a congregation}$

WHEREAS	1) learning God's Word is the core of any Christian life; and
WHEREAS	2) continuing education requirements are a common practice today with examples including nurses and other medical occupations, teachers, CPAs, child care providers, pest controllers, plumbers, and military personnel; and
WHEREAS	3) decisions made with adequate biblical knowledge are critical for the future of the synod and individual congregations; therefore be it
Resolved,	a) that positions that exercise authority over a given congregation, such as elders, board members, committee chairs, and voters will be required to take part in continuing education; and be it further
Resolved,	b) that continuing education will consist of an online format with multiple choice questions at the end (80 percent pass rule); and be it further
Resolved,	c) that the synod will provide an alternate method of testing if a given individual is not comfortable with the online format; and be it further
Resolved,	d) that required units per year will be determined according to the responsibility of the position; and be it finally
Resolved,	e) that only those male members who accumulated the required units can fill the corresponding position.
