Resolution No. 01

<u>Resolved</u>, b) that we urge all congregations to make use of the resources provided by the MCG as they cheerfully plan their annual CMO; and be it further

Resolved, c) that we recommend the MCG continue to work faithfully and optimistically with the COP as it manages CMO and other funding opportunities; and be it finally

<u>Resolved</u>, d) that we accept the report of the Ministry of Christian Giving Review Committee and that we endorse the addition of one full-time Christian Giving Counselor starting in the second year of the current biennium.
