**Subject: To Declare Formal Fellowship with the Christian Lutheran Evangelical Church of Taiwan**

Resolution No. 02

WHEREAS 1) the Christian Lutheran Evangelical Church (CLEC) of Taiwan has been formed and exists as an independent confessional church; and

WHEREAS 2) unity in faith between the CLEC and the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod has been evidenced by a common commitment to the Holy Scriptures, to the Lutheran Confessions, and to the doctrinal position of the Confessional Evangelical Lutheran Conference (CELC); and

WHEREAS 3) the Commission on Inter-Church Relations unanimously recommends a formal declaration of fellowship with the Christian Lutheran Evangelical Church of Taiwan; therefore be it

Resolved, a) that we thank God for allowing the Christian Lutheran Evangelical Church of Taiwan to be formed as a confessional Lutheran church with whom we enjoy unity in faith and doctrine; and be it further

Resolved, b) that WELS officially declare fellowship with the Christian Lutheran Evangelical Church of Taiwan; and be it finally

Resolved, c ) that we ask God to give joy and blessing to both of our church bodies through this fellowship.
